Research, awards and grants

Clinical research

SIR Foundation hosts research consensus panels (RCPs) and research summits to discuss critical research needs in IR and determine how the priority topic can be further developed. In 2024, SIR Foundation held an RCP on locoregional therapies for thyroid cancer and a donor-sponsored research summit to explore healthy equity in uterine fibroid treatment.

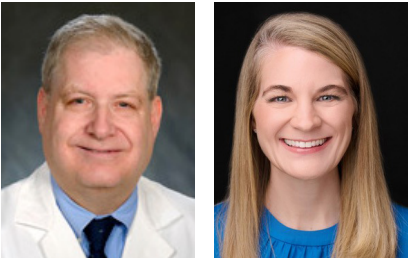

EMBOLIZE

A NEW GROUND-BREAKING CLINICAL TRIAL EXPLORING TREATMENTS FOR PELVIC VENOUS DISORDER, IS LAUNCHED

In March 2024, SIR Foundation, The VIVA Foundation and Penumbra, Inc., launched the EMBOLIZE trial, a first-of-its-kind prospective, randomized controlled trial studying the effects of ovarian vein embolization (OVE) and pelvic vein embolization in reducing pain in women experiencing chronic pelvic pain due to pelvic venous disease (PeVD).

An investigator-initiated clinical trial, EMBOLIZE is led by Ronald S. Winokur, MD, FSIR, professor of clinical radiology at Weill Cornell Medicine, and Gloria Salazar, MD, FSIR, associate professor of radiology at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Both will serve as the national co-principal investigators.

The study will enroll women over the age 18 who have dilated uterine, ovarian vein or pelvic veins that are causing chronic pain and be conducted at five sites. The sites are Weill Cornell Medicine (New York), University of North Carolina (Chapel Hill), Lake Washington Vascular (Bellevue, Washington), Northwestern University (Chicago) and Massachusetts General Hospital (Boston).

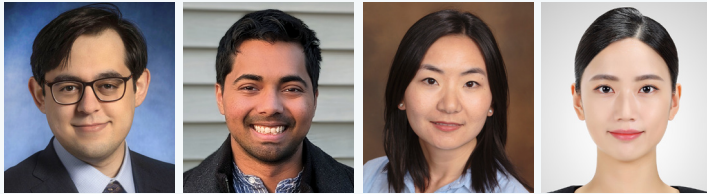
To determine efficacy, the study will compare changes in the patients' pain scores on a visual analog scale from 4 weeks before treatment through 6 months post-treatment to evaluate the outcome of vein-directed intervention for venous origin chronic pelvic pain. Investigators will also evaluate other quality of life improvements, improvements in the pelvic vein varices, and changes in pain medication usage.

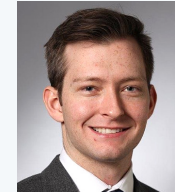

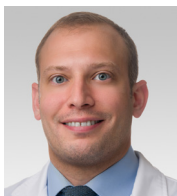

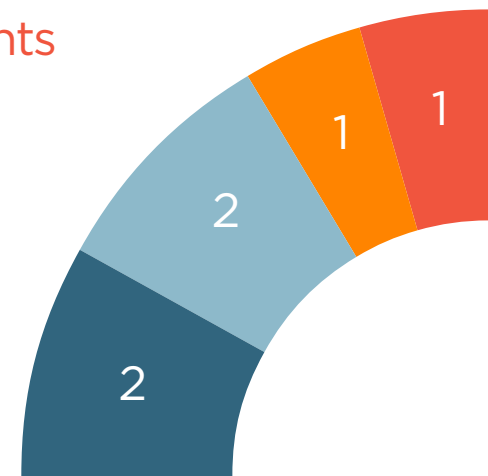

Spotlight

“My name is Connor Parrish; I am an incoming second-year medical student at the St. Louis University School of Medicine. In 2024, I had the privilege of working with Dr. White and the faculty at Medical College of Wisconsin as an SIR Foundation Summer Medical Intern. My days started with board meetings, such as the Liver Tumor Board and the Morbidity and Mortality Conference. We then had table rounds where we went through the plan of every case for the day as well as every relevant in-patient. I scrubbed into a wide variety of cases, ranging from HHT PAVM embolization, osteoid osteoma radiofrequency ablation, Y-90 radioembolization, GI bleeds, and a rendezvous percutaneous transhepatic cholangiogram with GI. I spent afternoons working on a local research project, looking at ascites resolution after transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic shunt (TIPS) placement. I enjoyed integrating this novel procedure with the pathophysiology I learned over this year, and it was even cooler to see the shunt being created and the stent being placed with my own eyes. I was also able to explore Milwaukee. Lake Michigan is beautiful, and the custard here is nothing like you’ve had before. The gem of IR truly is the people. **I could not be more grateful to have this immersive experience and meet such talented physicians early in my medical career.** I hope to provide similar opportunities for trainees in the future and am eager to meet more of this community. Thank you, SIR Foundation.”

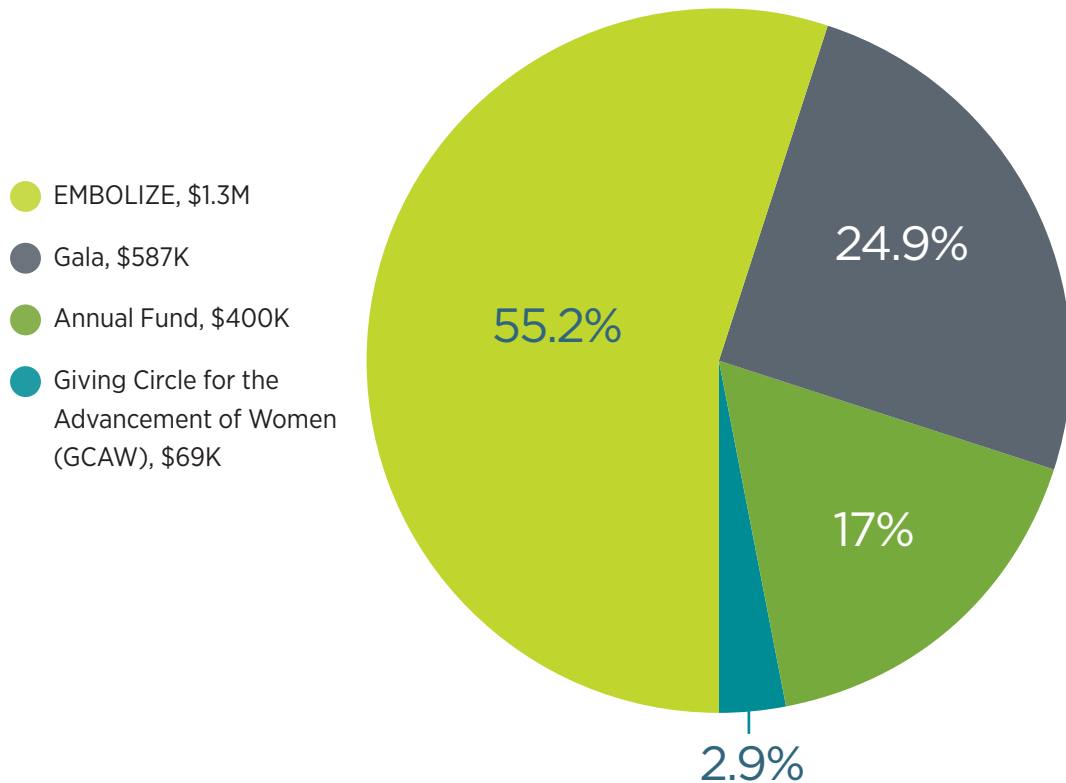

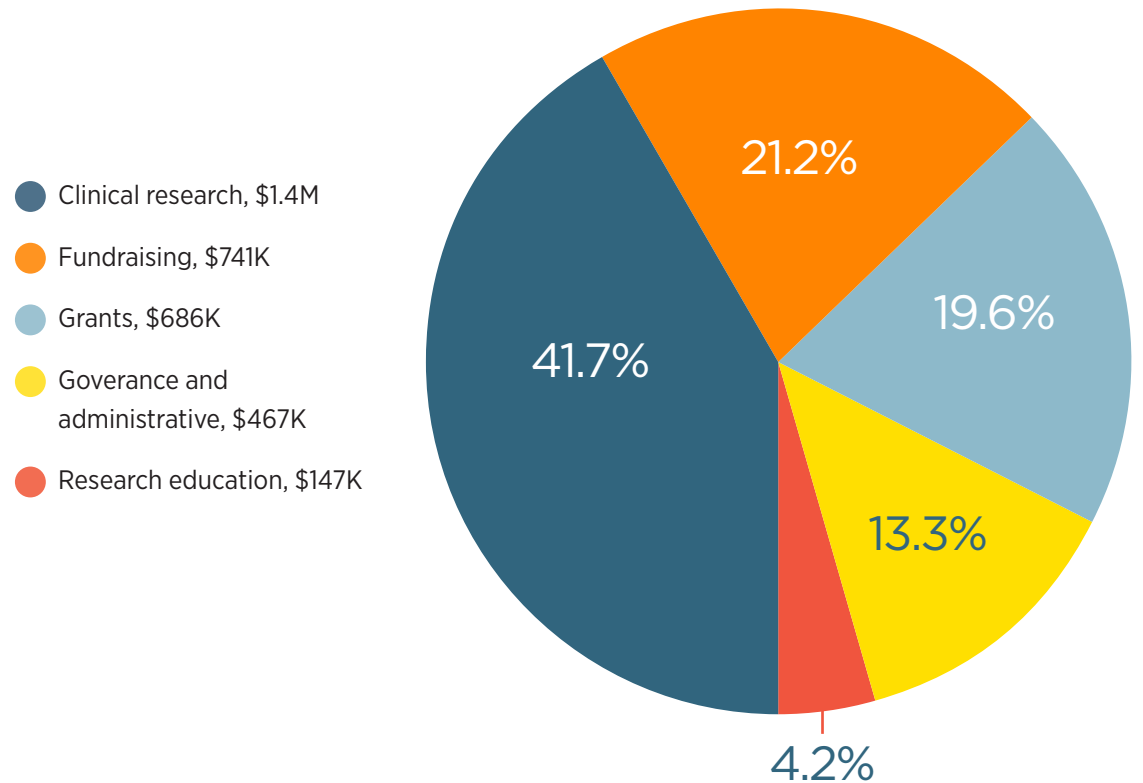
